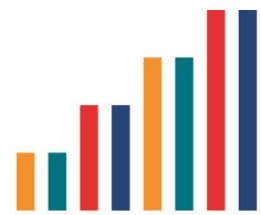

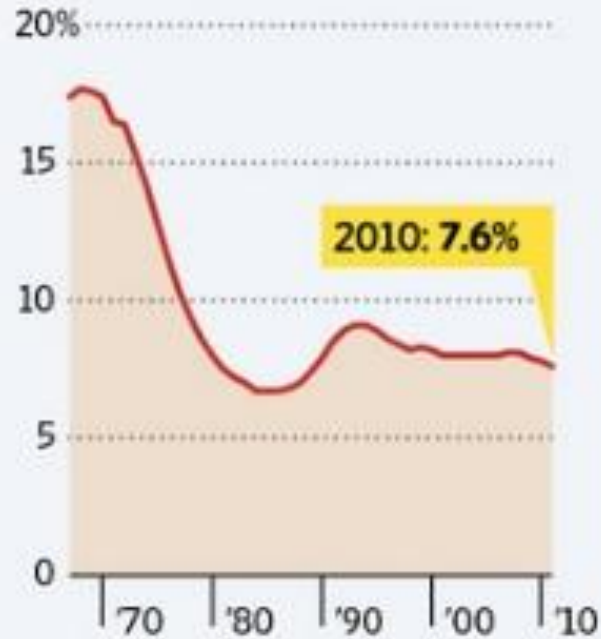

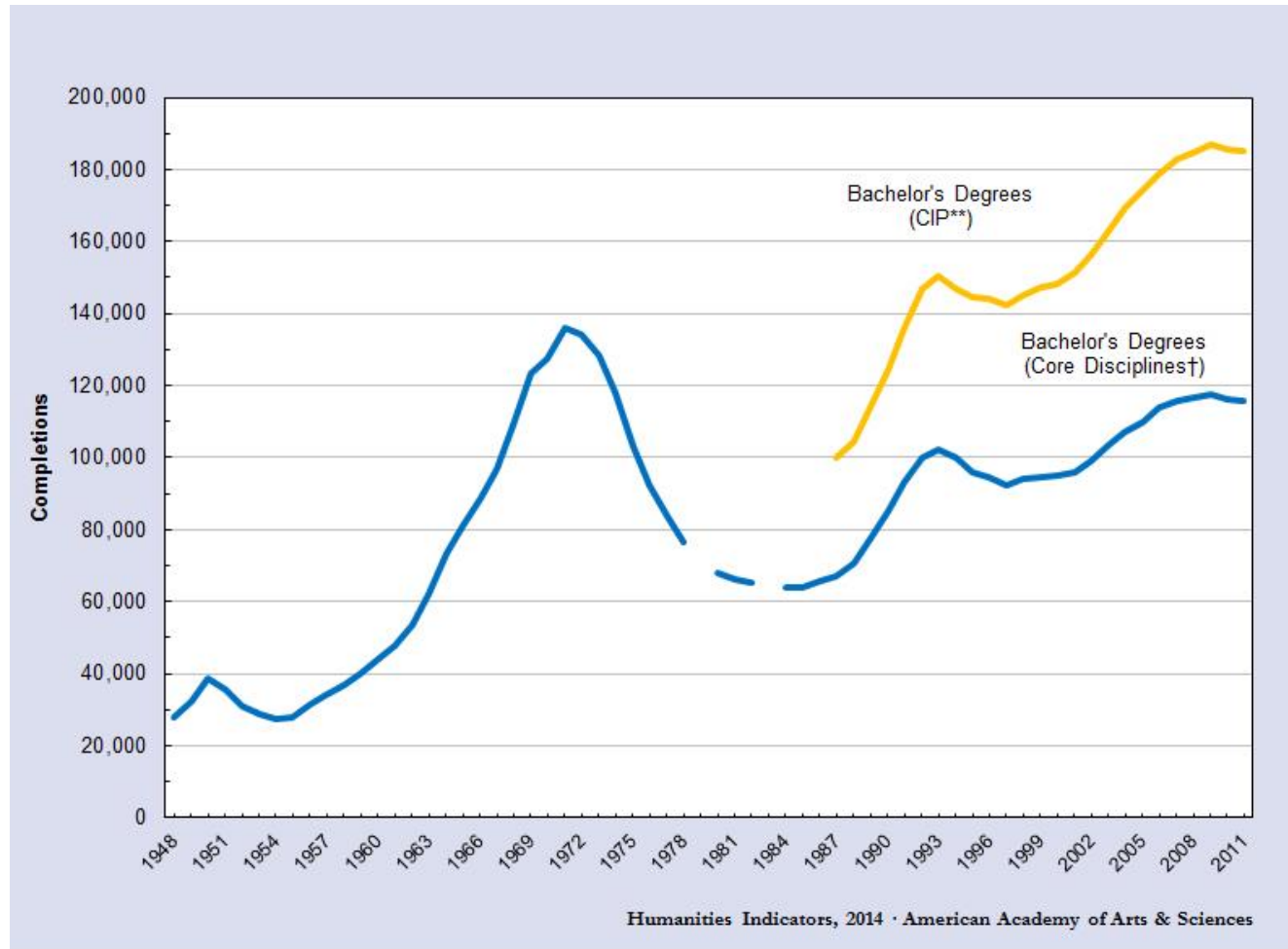
Percentage of bachelor's degrees

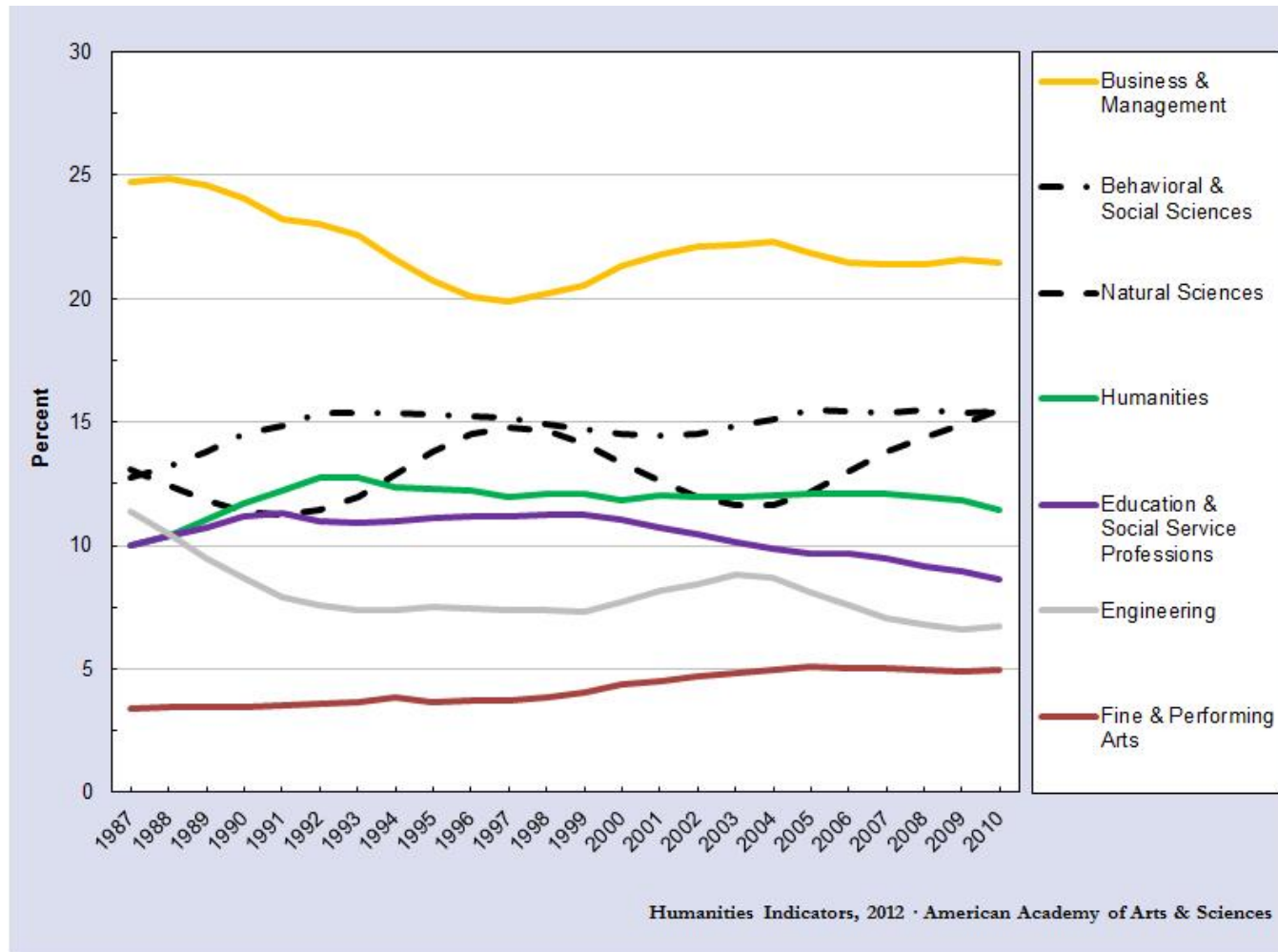


Bachelor's Degree Completions in the Humanities, 1948–2011



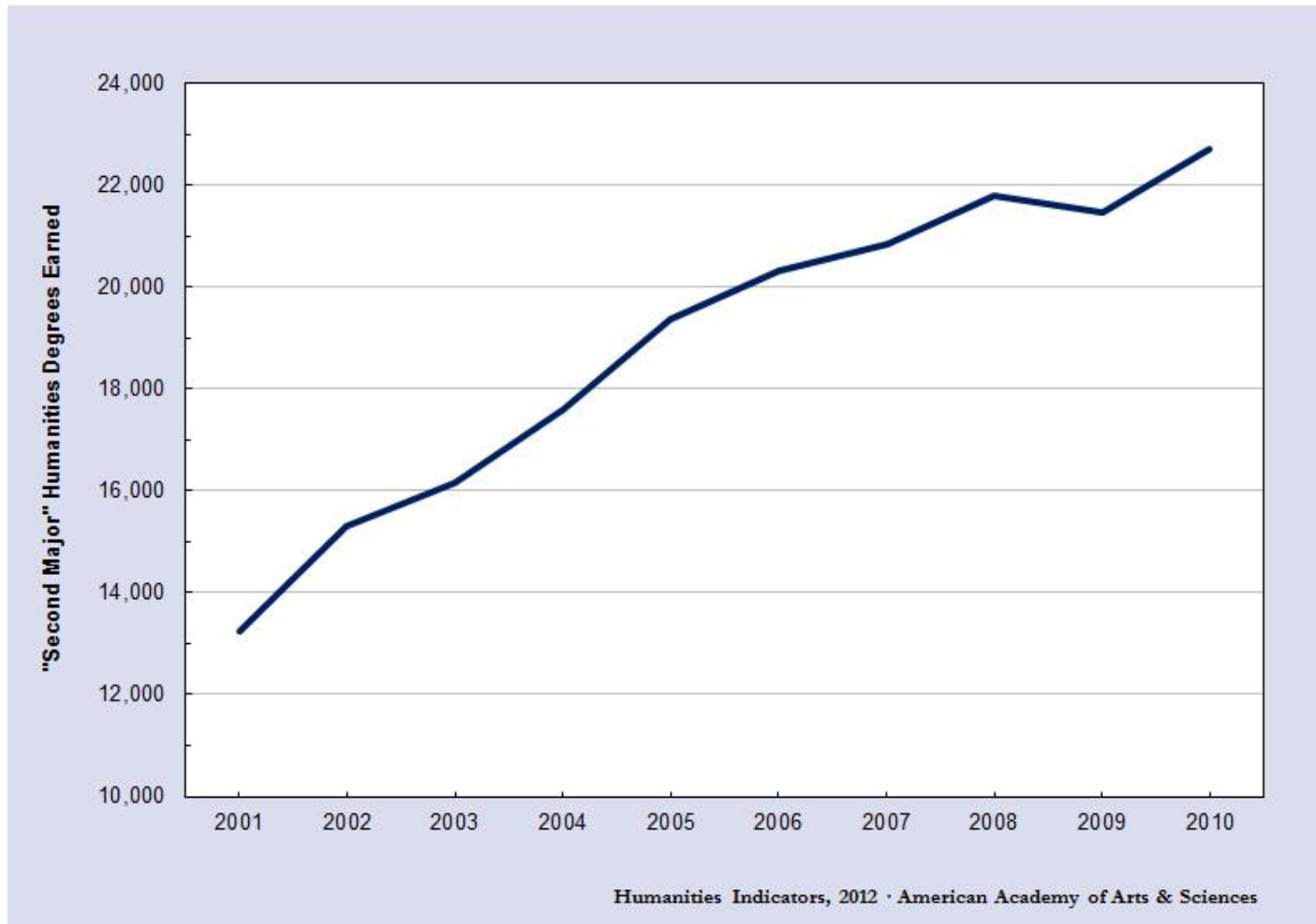


Share of All Bachelor's Degrees Awarded in Field, 1987–2010



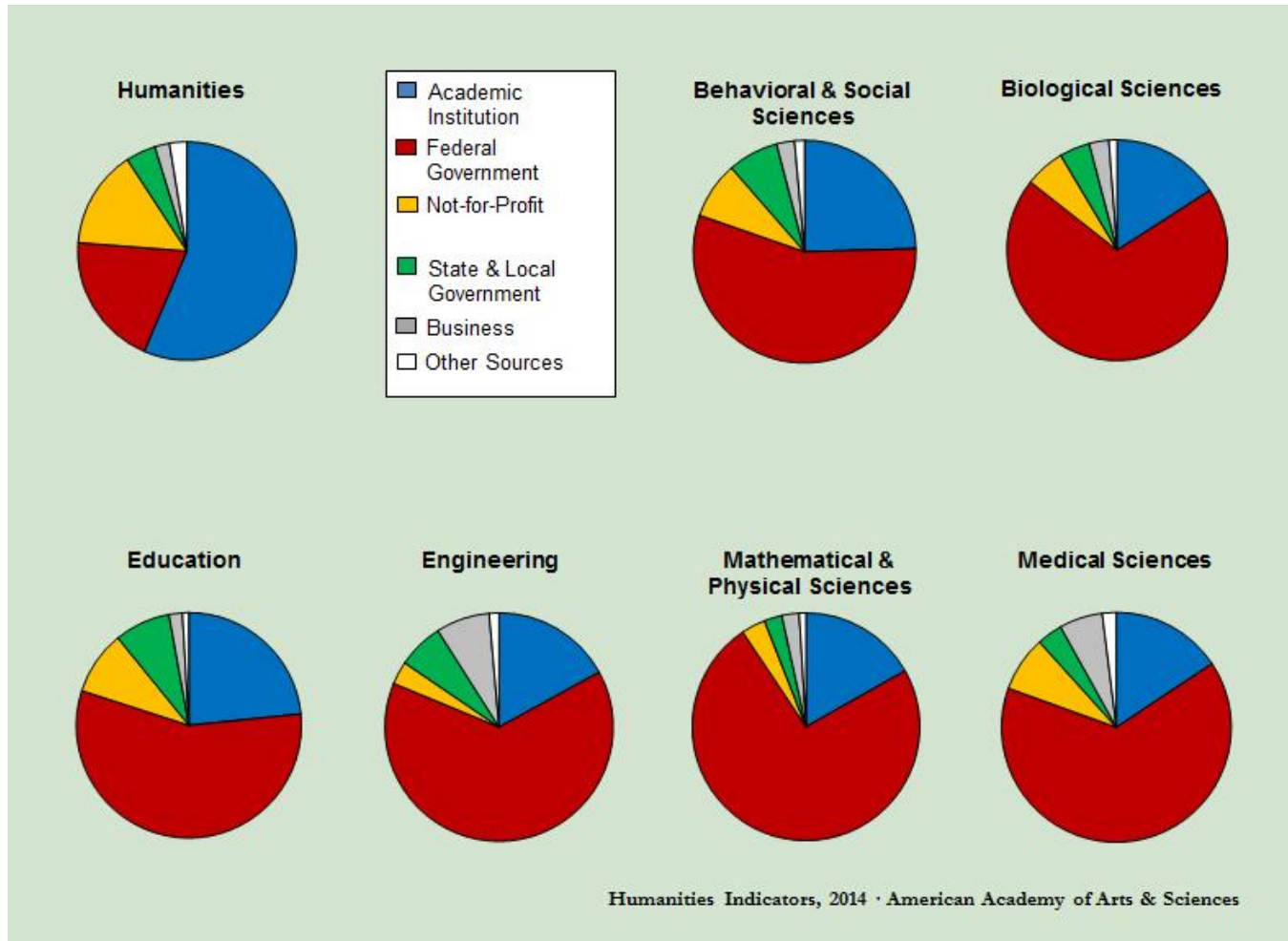


Humanities Bachelor's Degrees Earned as "Second Majors," 2001–2010



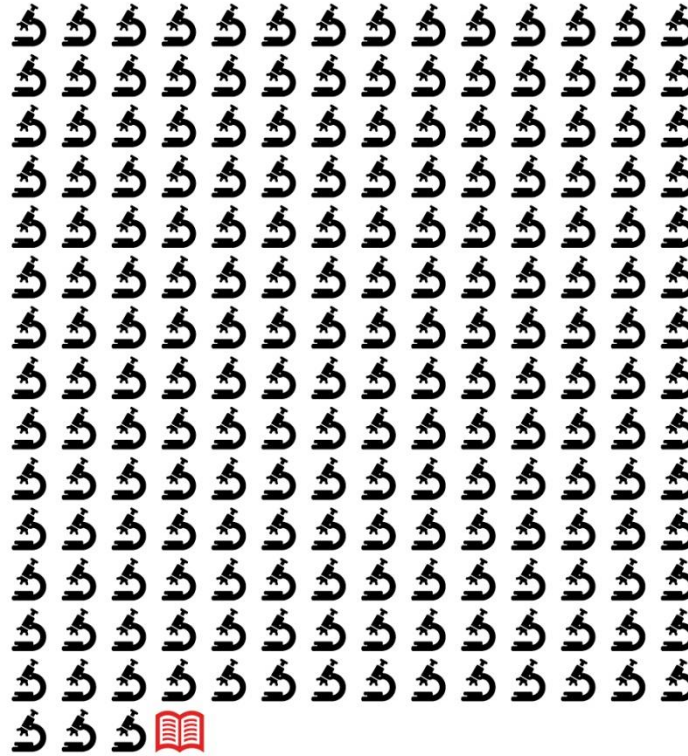


Sources of Funding for Academic Research and Development, FY 2011
