- 8. Student Admissions
- 9. Student Support Services
- 10. Faculty
- 11. Educational Offerings
- 12. General Education
- 13. Related Educational Activities
- 14. Assessment of Student Learning

Historical Evolution

- 1965 Higher Education Act (HEA) compelled accreditors to comply with HEA criteria to receive Title IV funding (amended many times)
- Amendments in the 1980s and 1990s brought in "outcomes assessment" language
- 2000s brought more calls for accountability (i.e. Spellings Commission)

Focus of Last Decade

- Assessment should be done at every level of the institution (institutional assessment, course-based assessment, etc.)
- MSCHE stresses that assessment will not go away
- The "Teaching-Learning-Assessment Cycle" emphasized (closing the loop)

Middle States Mission

- Their goal is to help institutions reach their own goals
- "Make sure your students graduate with the learning you value."
- Institutions should cultivate a culture of assessment
